As a founding member of the Global Food Safety Initiative (GFSI)'s Food Safety Culture Technical Working Group, TAG Chief Scientific Officer <u>Dr. Rolando Gonzalez</u> stated, "Although 'culture' itself can be difficult to specifically define, a food business' food safety culture can be scientifically and measurably assessed to identify weaknesses, then implement improvements that impact both food safety and quality."
